
Confiteor:

Therefore, I ask the blessed Mary, ever virgin, all the angels and saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord, our God.



Glo-ry to you, Word of God, Lord Je-sus Christ!


- 1. If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.
- 2. One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.
- From the shining cloud the Father's voice is heard: This is my beloved Son, hear him. (listen to him.)
- Lord, you are truly the Savior of the world; give me living water, that I may never thirst again.
- 5. God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so (that) everyone who believes in him might have eternal life.
- Repent, says the Lord; the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 7. I am the light of the world, says the Lord; whoever follows me will have the light of life.

- I will get up and go to my Father and shall say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.
- I am the resurrection and the life, says the Lord; whoever believes in me will never die.
- 10. Whoever serves me must follow me, says the Lord; and where I am, there also will my servant be.
- 11. Even now, says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart; for I am gracious and merciful.
- 12. Christ became obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
